- The 2023 Patrick Rodgers Award has been won by Gianni Taranto (OR2014 and Dux
- Gianni has spent the last year working with the World Food Program (WFP) in Somalia, with the enormous responsibility of securing food for a large population, a significant proportion of which are in dire circumstances.
- His mother Tor joined The Rector and Dr Hine and the Rodgers Family to accept the award on his behalf.



Mark Moloney Gallantry Award

Mark Moloney OR1962 was awarded the Medal for Gallantry by the Governor General in July 2023

In 1967-1968, Mark was a Lieutenant and a Platoon Commander of 7 RAR in South Vietnam. The citation read:

"The Governor General is pleased to announce. Medal for Gallantry (MG) **Major (then Lieutenant) Mark Augustine Moloney** (retd).

For acts of gallantry in action in hazardous circumstances as the platoon commander 8 Platoon, Charlie Company, 7 Battalion, the Royal Australian Regiment at Bien Hoa Province on 7 February 1968."



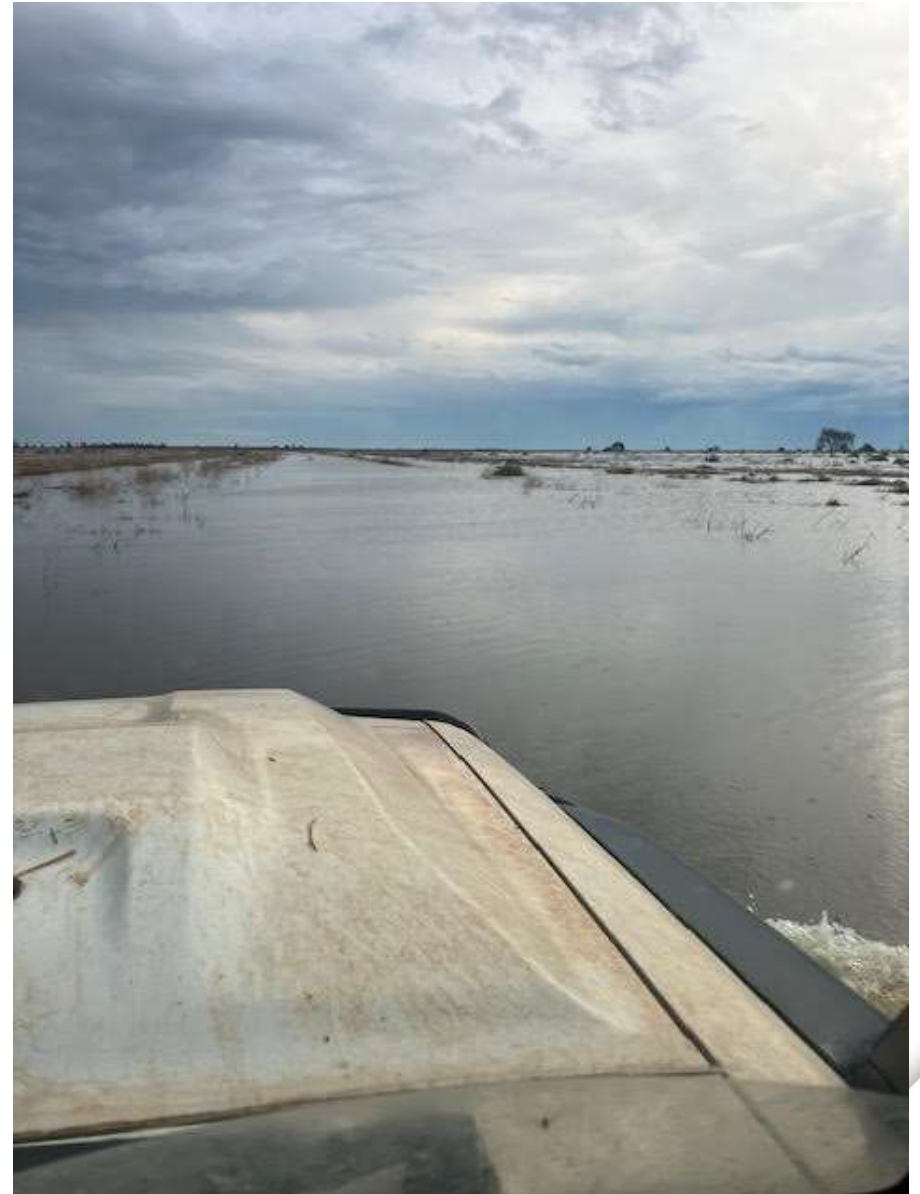

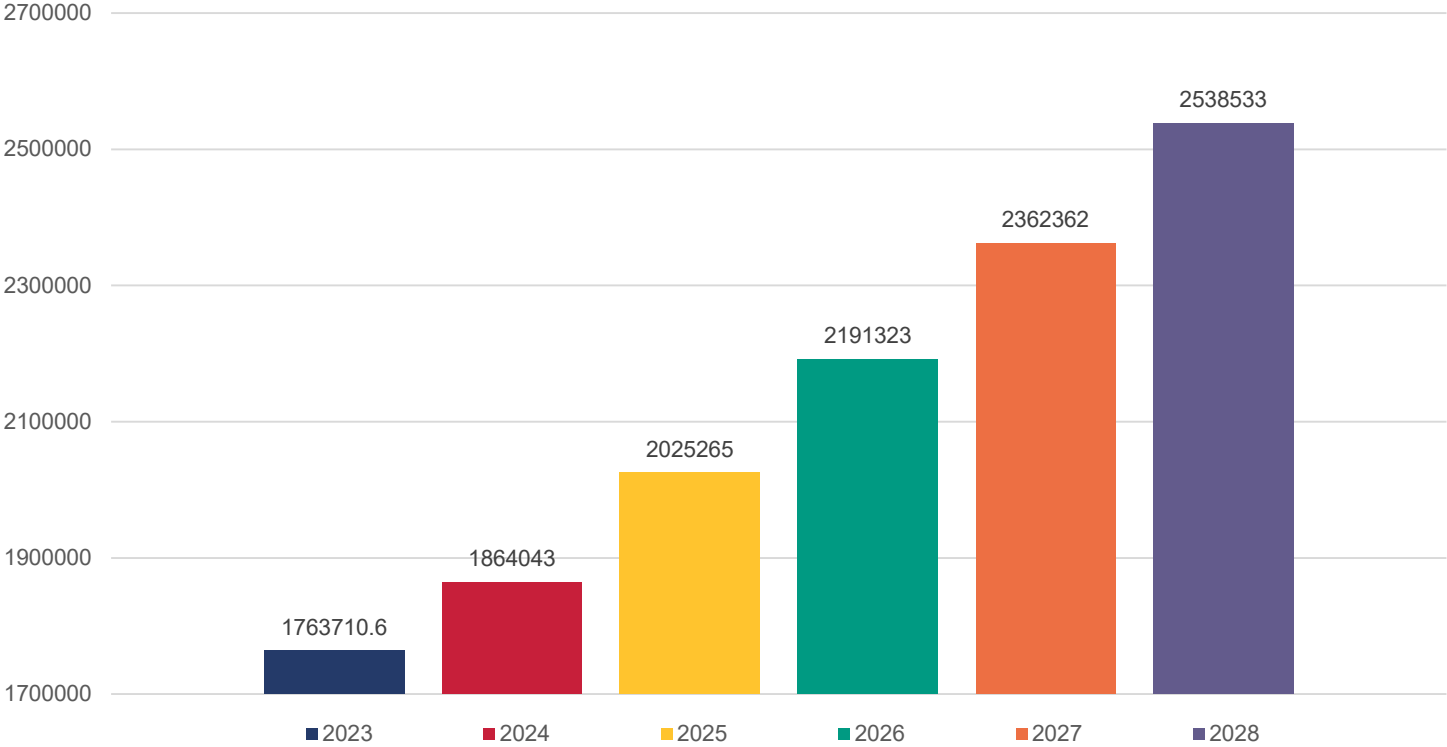
FY23 OIU INVESTMENT PORTFOLIO

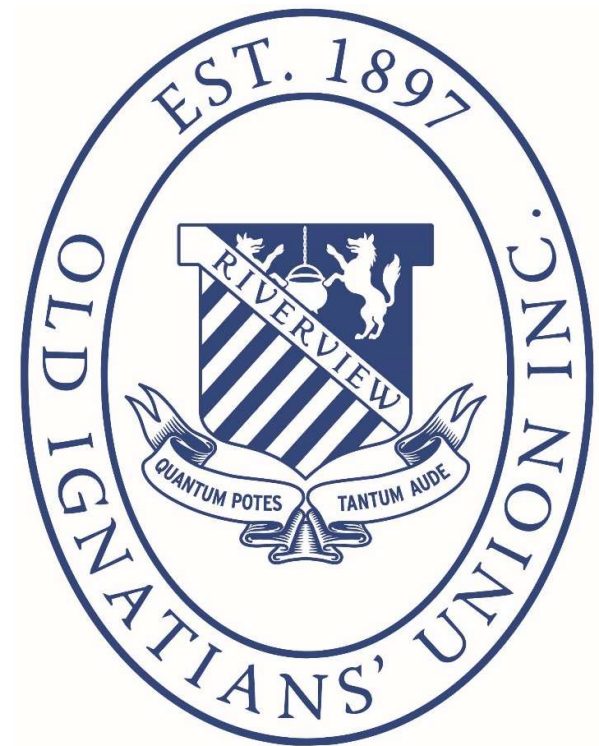
